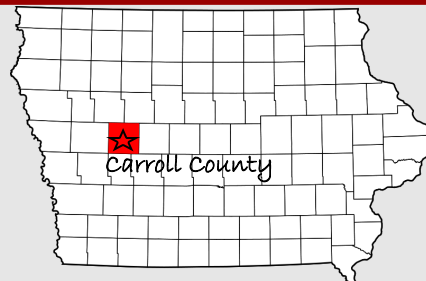

During the 2016 holiday season, a single mom, new to Carroll County, came into the FDC looking for assistance with her utilities. She was unfamiliar with local resources but needed help with a variety of life situations. After completing her LIHEAP application, she and the coordinator spoke further about her remaining needs. She was able to receive a food pantry and get signed up for a Thanksgiving food basket and Christmas toys. We also connected her to Head Start and WIC for her children. She left the center feeling optimistic and hopeful about her future!

Federal Poverty Guidelines FY 2018

The 2017—2018 Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

has been established to help qualifying low-income Iowa homeowners and renters pay for a portion of their primary heating costs for the winter heating season. The assistance is based on household income, household size, type of fuel, and type of housing.

These Federal Guidelines are based on 175%POV:

Household Size	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
30 Day Gross Income	\$1,759	\$2,368	\$2,978	\$3,588	\$4,197	\$4,807	\$5,416	\$6,026
* For each additional member add: \$610 for 30 Day Gross Income								
Annual Gross Income	\$21,105	\$28,420	\$35,735	\$43,050	\$50,365	\$57,680	\$64,995	\$72,310
* For each additional member add: \$7,315 for annual Gross Income
