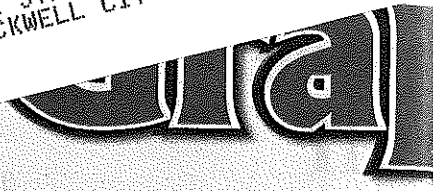

## County Attorney office broken into

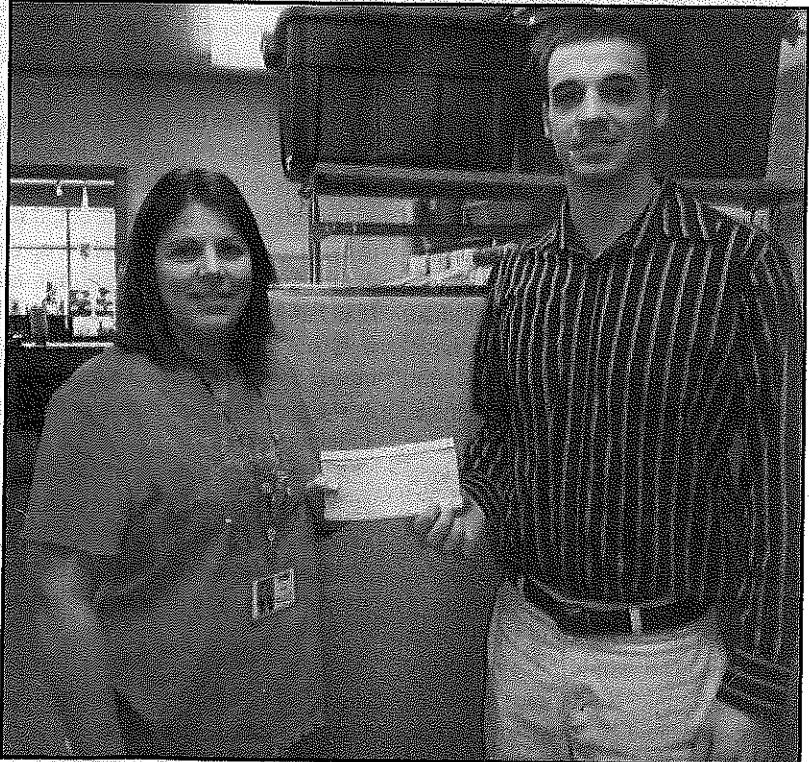
