Carroll County Farm Bureau donates to food pantries

At the Carroll County Farm Bureau annual meeting held July 15, many members made individual contributions toward the Carroll food pantries, which totaled \$400. The Carroll County Farm Bureau then matched this amount and President Jason Nieland presented a total of \$400 to each of the two food pantries. The New Opportunities Food Pantry is located at 23751

East Highway 30 in Carroll. Those needing help must first complete a basic intake form and verify proof of residency (Carroll County) and Social Security card or ID. They then receive a food package according to the number of people living in the household. Food pantry supplies may include meat, canned vegetables, cereal, soups, tuna, macaroni and cheese, hamburger helper etc.,

depending on the availability.

The second one is the Community of Concern Food Pantry which is located at 203 North Highway 71 in Carroll. This food pantry is recognized by the state of Iowa as an emergency pantry open to Carroll County residents. When making application for help, proof of residency and a photo ID are also required. There are no income guidelines as it

is based on emergency needs.

Both food pantries were grateful to the members of the Carroll County Farm Bureau who chose to donate and partner with them in helping to provide for those in need of help in our community.
