

2018-2019 LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM



The 2018—2019 Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is a federally-funded program that has been established to help qualifying low-income Iowa homeowners and renters pay for a portion of their primary heating costs for the winter heating season.

When to apply: **** Elderly (60+) and/or disabled:** **October 1, 2018 -- April 30, 2019**
 **** All other households:** **November 1, 2018 -- April 30, 2019**

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU: HOUSEHOLD INCOME GUIDELINES

Proof of Income

- Most Recent 1 Month OR
- Most Recent Federal Income Tax Form
- Include Check Stubs, Award Letters from Social Security, etc.

From the Same Time Period as Above include:

- FIP
- Child Support
- Pension
- OTHER Income Sources

Additional Items to Bring With You:

Social Security card or Driver's license documentation

- Names, Birth Dates of ALL in Household
- Most Recent Heat Bill
- Most Recent Electric Bill (if separate from Heat Bill)
