SHARE-ing about a program we love...

SHARE (Self Help and Resource Exchange) is a non-profit organization located in Oskaloosa, Iowa, SHARE is able to offer food at up to 50% off the supermarket price by contracting with food buyers from all over the country to purchase large quantities of high quality food at wholesale prices. Volunteers from all over Iowa come to the SHARE warehouse to sort, bag, and assemble food to send to many SHARE distribution sites across the state. Every month SHARE publishes a new menu. The menu includes frozen food, meats, vegetables and other grocery items. To purchase one or more food packages from SHARE, you can place and pay for your order at your local distribution site, or place your order online, and pickup at your local distribution site.

Some facts about purchasing food from SHARE:

-  There are no income guidelines—anyone can order food from SHARE!
-  There are no requirements to purchase food through SHARE, but they encourage you to volunteer in your community as your way of giving back!
-  You can pay for your SHARE packages using cash, check or EBT card.



New Opportunities has a SHARE distribution site in each of the seven counties we serve. When ordering through New Opportunities, orders are typically due by the first Friday of the month, and distribution is on the third Friday of the month.
