When to apply:

**** Elderly (60+) and/or disabled: October 1, 2021 -- April 30, 2022**

**** All other households: November 1, 2021 -- April 30, 2022**

Applications are taken at the below locations. You can apply In person, by Mail, Phone, Fax or Online. Must apply in the county you reside in. During your LIHEAP appointment, be sure to ask the FDC Coordinator in your county if you are eligible for our Weatherization Program.

- Keep heat in your home by turning off bath exhaust fans when not in use with a timer switch.
- Add Light Dimmers & Occupancy Sensors for a 20% or more savings on lighting costs.
- Using your fireplace instead of a traditional heater can save you up to 50% on your heating costs.
- Cleaning or replacing your furnace's filter twice a year can slash your heating costs by up to 10%.
- Save \$1000s on your energy costs by installing the right Energy Star rated furnace, a geothermal heating pump or boilers with an electric ignition.
- Reverse your ceiling fans in the winter to recirculate trapped heat by the ceiling and save up to 10%.
- Save up to 10% off your energy bill by removing solar panels or sun blocking curtains.
- Set your heater to 68° when you're home & 55° when you're gone to cut your energy costs by up to 20%.



Ask about the New Water Assistance called **LIHWAP** (Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program). LIHWAP can pay past due water bills and pay reconnection fees. To be Eligible, you must be under the income maximum and demonstrate a water burden. Same guidelines as LIHEAP. See your county FDC Coordinator for more information on this new program.
