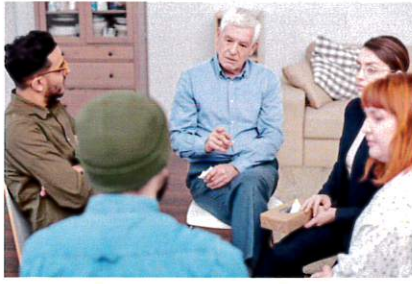

Opioids are a class of drugs that include prescribed pain relievers such as oxycodone, hydrocodone, codeine, morphine, demerol, fentanyl, dilaudid, norco, lortab, atarax and many others.

It can also include illegal substances such as opium, heroin and others.
